# **ACTIVITY: TUPPERWARE ROUNDUP**

### **WHAT YOU NEED:**

5-10 Tupperware containers with lids. (You can get creative and even make your own craft to use as well)

### WHAT YOU DO:

Give each person 2-4 containers with lids to match. Everyone should keep the bottom of the container and put the lids in a big pile all together. Have someone call out "GO!" and then everyone races to be the first to find their matching lids and put their Tupperware containers together.

For an added twist, divide your family into two teams. Keep time on your phone as one team works as fast as they can to put all the Tupperware containers back together. You can even make it more challenging by hiding the lids throughout the house. When they finish, it's the other teams turn to try to beat their time.

### TALK ABOUT THE BIBLE STORY:
